ATTENDANCE AND AVAILING OF LEAVE

Students should attend classes regularly and punctually

- 1. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of every lecture hour.
- 2. A student has to score not less than 75% of attendance in the number of working days in a semester to become eligible to appear for the University Exams.
- 3. A student who absents herself without permission during any one hour of the day will be marked absent for half-a-day.
- 4. Leave application should be submitted in the prescribed form.
- 5. In all cases application for leave should be submitted in advance, in unforeseen circumstances it is to be submitted on the very next day.

IDENTITY CARD

Each student of the College is required to possess an identity card with her passport size photo affixed and her signature attested by the Principal. If ID card is lost duplicate ID card will be issued to the student on payment of Rs.100/-

EXAMINATIONS

- 1. The progress of the students is assessed by means of Internal Assessment Tests, Mid Semester, Model Examination conducted on the notified dates.
- 2. It is mandatory that all students should appear for the Tests and Examinations.
- 3. The absence of students from examinations without proper reason or leave will be seriously dealt with.
- 4. Parents will be informed through phone about their ward's leave, attendance percentage and academic progress.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

Hall Ticket for the Semester Examinations will be issued only to those students who fulfill the following conditions:

- 1. 75% attendance in both theory and practical classes.
- 2. Submission of No Dues certificate obtained from the College Office, College Library, Head of the Department, Physical Directress etc.

Students will be permitted to take up the University Examination only when they produce their ID cards and Examination Admission cards.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The College Library is computerized and is equipped with a wide collection of books, journals, magazines and newspapers.

WORKING HOURS: 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Students should leave their books and notebooks in the allotted place before they enter the library.
- 2. Students using the Library should bring their ID cards.
- 3. Each student will be given two borrower's tickets. These tickets must be kept under careful custody, as the student who is issued the ticket will be held responsible for any book borrowed against it.
- 4. Reference books and Periodicals should be used only in the library.

- 5. On receiving a book, the student should examine the condition of the book. If there is any damage, it should be brought to the notice of the Librarian. Otherwise, the student will be held responsible for the damage.
- 6. No person shall write upon, damage or mark on any part of the book.
- 7. A student will be allowed to keep the book for 7 days from the date of issue. It may be renewed for a further period of 7 days provided.
 - a. No other reader had applied for the book in the meantime.
 - b. Not more than three consecutive renewals are made for the same book.
- 8. Borrowed books should be returned on the due date or else a fine of Re 1 per day will be levied. If the due date falls on a holiday, the book should be returned on the following working day. Leave or absence from college will not be considered as an excuse.
- 9. Loss of library tickets should be reported immediately to the librarian. A duplicate ticket will be issued on payment of Rs.50/-
- 10. Borrowers are not permitted to circulate the library books among themselves.
- 11. Library tickets are not transferable.
- 12. Students using the library are prohibited from engaging in conversation or conducting themselves in any manner which would disturb or distract the attention of the readers. Perfect silence should be maintained in the library.
- 13. All tickets should be returned to the Library by students on completion of their course of study. No transfer / Conduct Certificate will be issued to a student until all the books and tickets and other dues outstanding against her are discharged.
- 14. The library staff is there to assist the readers with the selection of materials for their study.
- 15. Non-adherence to any of the rules or any other malpractice by any member will involve withdrawal of library facilities and severe disciplinary action.

EXTRA COACHING

Teaching will be imparted in such a way that private tuition will not be necessary for students who apply themselves studiously in class. However, in the case of some slow learners, we plan to provide them with extra coaching (outside the class hours) in the campus itself. In the same way, special care would be taken on high achievers so as to keep their standards better and higher.

DRESS CODE

- 1. Every student should wear clean, decent dress.
- 2. Students should wear the uniform every Monday defaulters will be punished.
- 3. On other days Girls can wear sarees, half sarees or chudidhars with proper dupattas.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

FEES AND PAYMENTS

There are two semesters in a year

- 1. Students should remit the prescribed fee for each semester within the stipulated time.
- 2. Fees will be collected between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on all working days.
- 3. Receipts issued for all payments should be kept safe.
- 4. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 5. In case of withdrawal (Discontinue) from the college, students should pay the fees for one academic year (Though the classes have not yet begun).
- 6. University Examination Fee is to be remitted within the time prescribed by the University.
- 7. Students should inform their parents well in advance all the details of the various fees to be remitted to the college.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All the students must assemble in their respective classrooms by 9:25 a.m. The day begins with a common morning prayer. After the prayer the class work begins at 9:30 a.m.
- 2. ID card must be brought to the college on all working days. It should be shown to any staff member on demand. Possession of ID card is essential till the completion of the course.
- 3. Important circulars relating to the day-to-day affair of the college will be on the notice board and the ignorance of any notice will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.
- 4. No meetings of any kind shall be organized in the college without prior permission of the Principal & Management.
- 5. Leave or permission to a group or whole class will not be granted on any account for the purposes of religious or social functions.

- 6. The student should report to the class-in-charge whenever there is a change in her residential address & phone numbers.
- 7. If any student wants to leave the campus for any reason, academic or non-academic should get prior permission from the HOD and the Principal.
- 8. Students can come to college either by college bus or by using their own vehicles (Two Wheelers). Travelling by auto-rickshaw or private buses should be avoided.
- 9. Student should use only the allotted bus and from the permitted place.
- 10. Students are asked not to reserve seats for the co-students in the bus.
- 11. Only Parents and Guardians should come to meet the college in person to discuss the student's progress.
- 12. In the event of violating the rules and regulations of the college, the Principal is fully empowered to dismiss the students from the college.
- 13. No outsiders are permitted to visit students without getting written permission from the College office.
- 14. Loitering in the verandah and sitting on the staircases are not allowed.
- 15. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any student found to be indulging in such acts will be dealt with according to provisions of the relevant act.
- 16. Students are restricted to use mobile phone in the campus.

- 21. The cost of damage done to buildings, furniture, library books, sports goods, etc, must be borne by the students.
- 22. Students should all times show respect and deference to the College Authorities, to the members of staff and to the elders.
- 23. Girls are advised not to bring any valuables such as gold chains, costly watches or other articles to the college. The college will not be responsible for the loss of such belongings.
- 24. Students should not interfere in other students affairs. They should not bring other students or student organization or politicians for recommendations Students should not be a member of any students' organization or movements or political parties. If found indulging in such activities, they will be dismissed.

- 25. Students are not allowed to exchange gifts or compliments among themselves.
- 26. The students participating in inter-collegiate meets should behave decently to keep the dignity and decorum of the college.
- 27. Students should not gather inside or outside the college campus unnecessarily and if such activity affects the name and the good will of the institution, they will be expelled from the college.
- 28. Students should uphold the moral standards of honesty, respect for elders & kindness towards all.
- 29. The decision of the college authorities shall be final in all matters of discipline and enforcement of rules.
- 30. We expect that the students entrusted to our care will conduct themselves to the satisfaction of all concerned and leave the College after a successful career as knowledgeable, God-fearing and self-reliant young woman, useful to themselves, their parents and our country.

Students and Parents have responsibility to know the rules and regulations of our college. Excuse would not be given, if they are not distinguished with the rules of the college.
